MONDAY'S FESTIVAL BELONGS TO TRAVELLER MIROSLAV ZIKMUND

Zlín – On the fourth day of the festival, we pay tribute to the traveller Miroslav Zikmund, whose 100th birthday has inspired the theme of this year's ZFF: Explore & Discover. The screening of the film *The Century of Miroslav Zikmund* will be accompanied by a discussion with travellers and followers of the legendary traveler. There will also be the opening of the project Z100 exhibition, which set out to follow in the footsteps of H + Z after almost sixty years. An additional two trees will be added along the festival avenue, which will be planted by the Young Stars of this year's Zlín Film Festival. The winners of the Joy of Creation art competition for children with visual impairments will be announced. Regional bands will be given the opportunity to perform in the concert zone.
